# Workshops and Mini-Grants!



### JUMPSTART GRANTSMANSHIP WORKSHOPS:

The NSF HSI STEM Resource Hub offers Jumpstart Grantsmanship Workshops aimed to coach proposers in competitive grantwriting for science education proposals. These trainings focused on preparing faculty currently working at HSIs and MSIs across the country. This training is free of charge for participants from HSIs and is supported by the NSF HSI STEM Resource Hub under awards 1832338 and 1832345.

### GANAS MINIGRANT COMPETITION:

The NSF HSI STEM Resource Hub hosted its first GANAS Minigrant competition this year; submissions closed January 17. These planning minigrants are funded up to \$12,500 and are awarded to project leaders developing a research project, building partnerships, identifying and working with an evaluator, preparing an IRB, and writing a proposal for the NSF HSI Program Solicitation (NSF 19-540). Submitted minigrants are currently in review and The Hub will award 8 proposals this year.
